








Schloss Hof Schloss Hof is a palace located in Marchfeld, Austria near the border with Slovakia. It once belonged to Prince Eugene of Savoy who purchased it late in his life in 1726. He had it enlarged in the Baroque style by the architect Johann Lukas von Hildebrandt in 1729, and used it as an elaborate hunting lodge.



Restaurant Althof, Retz






Retz is a town with a population of 4,168 in the Hollabrunn District in Lower Austria, Austria.
